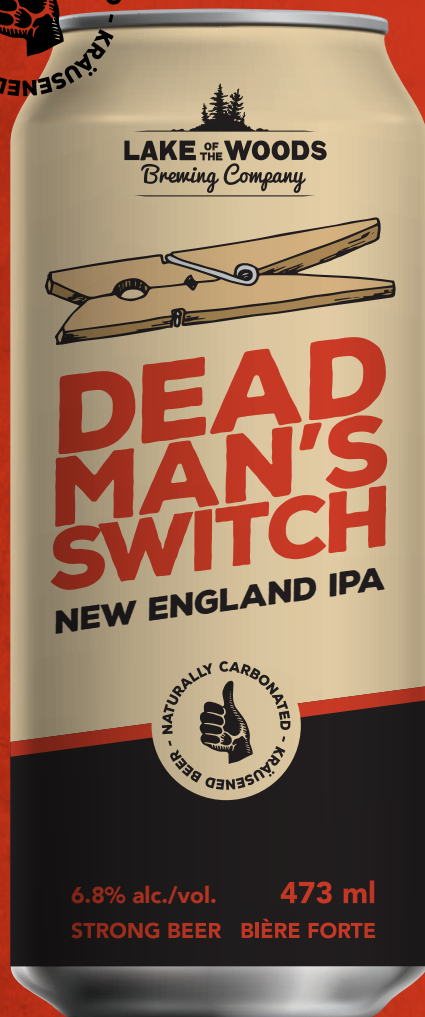


DEAD MAN'S SWITCH

Dead Man's Switch - a hazy NEIPA hop bomb loaded with enough Citra & Amarillo to stuff a getaway car twice over - this brew immortalizes the surreal & film-esque Kenora Main St. bank robbery; the only such event in history that actually shut down the Trans-Canada Hwy. for a day. **Best consumed while doing laundry.**

TASTING NOTES & VITAL STATS

BEER STYLE:	New England IPA
COLOUR:	Straw to yellow, hazy opaque clarity
AROMA:	Hop aroma of tropical fruit & citrus, without being grassy. Clean, neutral malt in the background with a light bready sweetness
HEAD:	White head with high to very high retention
HOPS:	Citra, Amarillo
MOUTHFEEL:	Medium to medium-full body with a smooth character. Medium carbonation
TASTE:	Low to medium bitterness, low to medium malt flavour with bready, grainy, light sweet flavour
INGREDIENTS:	Water, Malted barley, Malted wheat, Flaked oats, Hops, Yeast
VITAL STATS:	ABV: 6.8% IBU: 40 SRM: 5
